Training Services NSW, Aboriginal Services provides the following services:



Aboriginal Training Coordinators

Provide specialist advice and support to Aboriginal apprentices, trainees and employers to improve access to

employment and help in the workplace to improve the chances of Aboriginal people finishing their training and maintaining employment. They will work with community and government bodies to develop vocational training pathways for Aboriginal people into employment or further training.



New Careers for Aboriginal People (NCAP)

The NCAP program aims to increase the participation of Aboriginal people in the labour market by identifying, creating

and supporting opportunities for sustainable education, training and employment. Services available include career planning, writing a resume, training, job referral and interview preparation. The NCAP program assists Aboriginal people to find pathways to work and training, or to improve their current job situation.



The Way Ahead for Aboriginal People (TWAP)

This is a **FREE** mentoring program that helps Aboriginal apprentices and trainees create an

environment that assists them to achieve their personal best and develop to their full potential. Aboriginal Mentors provide support and advice in the workplace to employees, to supervisors and employers if needed. Aboriginal mentors provide support and advice in the workplace to employers.



Aboriginal Enterprise Development Officer (AEDO)

The AEDO program aims to increase the confidence and expertise of Aboriginal people to

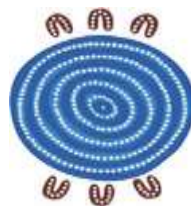

Services available include assisting Aboriginal clients in setting up a business, assisting in the development of business plans, arrange small business training and provide ongoing business support and mentoring.



The Elsa Dixon Aboriginal Employment Program (ADAEP)

The EDAEP focuses on creating employment and work experience opportunities for

Aboriginal people in the public service, local government and community groups by providing salary, training and other support costs.



Aboriginal Workforce Development

Aboriginal Services support's industry by providing a one-stop Aboriginal employment advisory service. The purpose is to create

and delivery workforce development strategies to employers and industry sectors wanting to employ and retain Aboriginal apprentices and trainees in their workforce.
